Competition:

- CONTEST Eurotour and FAI World Cup, FAI category II event.
- The contest will be conducted in accordance with the latest FAI Sporting code.
- Local rules will be announced at the briefings.
- Group scoring will be used if necessary. Rounds will be divided into three groups.
- Maximum number of contestants: the first 40 to pay. Initially, 50 contestants will be registered on the start list. If more than ten drop out, the start list will be topped up from the waiting list to a maximum of 40 contestants. Every contestant on the starting list has the right to participate.
- Danish pilots will be pre-registered.
- A waiting list is created in [F3Xvault](https://f3xvault.com).
- List of contestants is to be found on [F3Xvault](https://f3xvault.com).
- Number of rounds: Maximum 20.
